



## **Jinhua Chinese School COVID-19 Safety Protocol**

In an effort to keep all Jinhua Chinese School students and staff healthy and safe during the COVID-19 pandemic, we will be following the state regulations and recommendations by the CDC. Below are some key highlights:

**Masks** To mitigate the spread of coronavirus, Jinhua Learning Center will require **all** individuals inside the building to wear a properly fitting mask which covers both the nose and mouth, regardless of vaccination status.

**Social Distancing** Inside classrooms, desks will be arranged to allow for maintaining at least three feet of distance between students and teachers.

Students may eat and drink in designated well-ventilated areas while maintaining social distancing.

**Frequent Hand Washing or Sanitizing** Facility patrons and staff are encouraged to wash their hands or use alcohol-based hand sanitizers often, especially before eating, and after contact with public surfaces. Hand sanitizer will be available in classrooms.

**Cleaning** Jinhua Learning Center will wipe down desks and surfaces before and after use.

**Ventilation** Windows and doors will be open to increase ventilation whenever and wherever possible.

**Self-Screening** Per CDC guidelines, all Jinhua Learning Center students, parents, and faculty are required to stay home if experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, including:

- frequent coughing;
- fever;
- difficulty breathing;
- chills;
- muscle aches;

- sore throat;
- intestinal issues;
- or recent loss of taste or smell.

Students, parents, and faculty are required to stay home if they, or anyone in their home, are experiencing symptoms, has tested positive for COVID-19, and/or is currently in quarantine. Students that display or experience COVID-19 symptoms during class will be asked to go home and get tested.

### **Keeping Students & Parents Informed**

We will send periodic ***COVID-19 Update*** email messages to:

- notify students, parents, and teachers of a reported COVID-19-positive individual who may have been contagious while at a facility and/or in a program;
- inform of changes to our programming or protocols as state guidelines evolve; or
- share tips about how to stay healthy and remind students, parents, and teachers of our safety guidelines.
